2017 RECYCLED SCULPTURE CONTEST

ADULT DIVISION

Contest Rules

Adult Division (19+): Individuals or teams may submit a sculpture. Limit one sculpture per team. Teams may only consist of 2 members. There is currently not a fee for participating in this contest. Future adult division contests may allow larger works utilizing public artwork guide lines.

Rules:

1. At least 70% of the sculpture must be constructed using primarily something previously used that would normally be thrown away or recycled after it is used (Examples: plastic bags, cardboard, plastic bottles, soda cans, newspaper).
2. Glue, nails, adhesives, and other materials needed to hold the sculpture together are permissible; these items should not be a focal point. Consider using only repurposed materials to hold your piece together (twist ties, old string, etc.).
3. Make sure all recycled materials are visible (not covered up). Do not use paint, crayons, or markers on the sculpture. Judges will want to see the actual recyclables and other materials used in the sculpture.
4. Sculpture may not exceed 2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. Sculpture may not weigh more than 25 lbs. Sculpture must be able to sit, stand, or hang (mobile) independently. Sculpture cannot hang on walls.
5. All materials used in the construction of the sculpture must be clean, odor-free, non-perishable, non-toxic, and non-gas-emitting.
6. Sculpture must be easily portable without falling apart. All parts must be permanently fixed.
7. Sculptures may NOT contain any material that may be offensive. All sculptures must be "family friendly" (nothing obscene or offensive)
8. Sculptures may not have been previously shown or entered in any other contest or displayed prior to the recycled sculpture contest. Previous entries in this contest may not be resubmitted.
9. All sculptures must have a title. Be creative.
10. Producers of this contest reserve the right to disqualify any entry that does not adhere to these rules and information contained within this document.

Registration Deadline: A registration form must be received by Thursday, April 20th 2017. Receipt of the registration form by the deadline is vital so that we may properly plan for the display of the recycled sculptures.

Delivering Sculptures: Deliver sculpture to the Burlison County Courthouse, Suite 303 on Thursday, April 20th 2017 or Friday, April 21st, 2017 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Please call 979-567-2007 to let us know you are bringing in the sculptures. **Sculptures must arrive complete with an identification label.** Identification labels must be filled out completely and attached to individual sculptures and visible for judging. Identification labels are located at the bottom of the registration form. Identification labels will NOT be provided during delivery.

Display: Sculptures will be on display on the second floor of the Burlison County Courthouse the week of April 22nd through April 29th and winners will be announced on April 22nd during the Trash Bash. During Burlison County's "Big Spring Clean" week of April 22nd – 29th, all first place entries will remain on display on the second floor of the courthouse and recognition of first place winners will take place at the Earth Day dinner on April 29th, 2017. Winners will be contacted with additional information prior to April 29th.

Presentation: Participants should be present for photographs and presentation of their sculptures. Presentations will begin at 5:00 p.m., April 22nd on the main stage at the courthouse followed by winner announcements. All participants will receive a free t-shirt. T-shirts should be picked up on the day of the Trash Bash, April 22nd.

Prizes: **First prize \$250 & two tickets to the Earth Day dinner (\$100 value), Second prize \$150, and Third prize \$100. First place winners are required to attend the Earth Day dinner at the Old Post Office across from the courthouse to receive their prize.** Other prizewinners will receive their prize within 15 business days of winner announcements.

Judging: Each sculpture will be judged for subject matter, construction methods, innovative use of recyclable materials, and if rules were followed by the participants.

Pick Up: Sculptures not awarded first place must be picked up on, April 22nd after the awards presentation at 5 p.m. Sculptures not picked up will be destroyed. Arrangements with first place winners will be made to allow sculptures to be picked up after Earth Day dinner on April 29.
